He has also appeared in the Court of Appeal (Criminal Division).

Throughout his shadowing period of pupillage, Calum experienced a wide variety of criminal trials, including murder, manslaughter, GBH, serious sexual offences, and fraud. Further, Calum worked on a range of procedural matters, such as applications to dismiss, submissions of no case to answer, and abuse of process arguments.

Notable Cases

R v L

Represented the Defendant in a sexual assault trial in circumstances where the defendant was unable to provide an account of the incident due to intoxication. The Defendant was acquitted.

R v S

Defendant was charged with harassment. Made a successful submission of no case to answer on the basis that the conduct, when considered in its social context, was not sufficiently distressing or alarming to meet the threshold for criminal liability. The Defendant was acquitted at the conclusion of the Crown's case.

R v H
